The Board of Trustees comprises:

- 6 members elected by Island Members, 3 of whom must be resident on the Isle of Dogs
- 2 members elected by the Tower Hamlets members of the Association
- 1 member appointed by the Councillors for Millwall ward on LBTH Council
- 1 member appointed in view of his/her interest and involvement in Education
- 1 member appointed by the Association of Island Communities Voluntary Council
- 2 members appointed by the Mudchute Allotment Society
- 2 members appointed for the relevant skills they are able to contribute

The Trustees normally meet on the second Thursday of each month

Every member of the Association undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Association, in the event of the same being wound up while he/she is a member, or within one year after he/she ceases to be a member, such amount as may be required not exceeding £1.50 each in the case of Island and Tower Hamlets Members and 50p each in the case of Associate Members.

Annual subscriptions become due on the anniversary of joining. If any Member fails to pay his/her subscription for any year within three months of the same being due (whether reminded or not) he/she shall cease to be a Member of the Association.

Membership:

Annual Subscription
