Brief History of the Mudchute

Before the docks, the skyscrapers and the DLR, there were cattle grazing on land known as Stebunheath (Stepney) Marsh.

Mudchute as we know it has its origins in the development of Millwall Docks. In 1875 mud from dredged docks was pumped onto fields by pneumatic transmission running under Eastferry Road. The area became known as the Mudfield, then the Mud Shoot and finally **the Mudchute**.

During WWII four concrete gun sites were established. While three have been adapted for livestock enclosures (see if you can spot them), the fourth is now the site of a restored anti-aircraft gun. Mudchute's allotments also played a role in WWI and WWII by providing a valuable source of food for people of the Island. Two of these allotment areas are still used by locals today.

In 1974 the Mudchute site was earmarked for construction of high rise housing. The resulting public campaign against these plans reflected the affection that local people and those working on the Island felt for The Mudchute. Their success secured it as the "People's Park", and in 1977 "The Mudchute Association" (Charity #284907) was formed to preserve and develop the area into a city farm.

For decades since, the Mudchute has worked to preserve and enhance the park and provide educational opportunities for local children. In April 2003 the area achieved Local Nature Reserve status and in 2018, thanks to generous donations from members of the "Friends of Mudchute" the Mudchute became the first Rare Breed approved centre in London.
